

Milovan Perić studied mechanical engineering in Sarajevo and graduated in 1980. He continued with postgraduate studies at Imperial College, London, where he obtained PhD-degree in 1985. He then worked as a research assistant and lecturer at the University of Erlangen from 1986 to 1991, visiting scholar at Stanford University in 1992 and as professor for fluid dynamics at the Institute of Shipbuilding in Hamburg from 1993 to 2001. From 2002 to 2013 he has worked for CD-adapco and held the positions of Director of Product Development, Director of Technology and Vice President for Technology. Since January 2014 he acts as a “senior corporate consultant” to CD-adapco (now part of Siemens PLM) and leads a consulting company CoMeT Continuum Mechanics Technologies GmbH. Since 2016 he also teaches “Applied CFD” and conducts research in fluid dynamics at the University of Duisburg-Essen. He has published many papers on CFD and is a co-author of a popular book on this subject (published by Springer in English, German, Japanese and several other languages).
